The Programme Volunteers (PVs) are a lively group of young women who help organise and run event programmes at Sangam World Centre. They run event sessions, give tours of the neighbourhood, lead discussions, learn Indian crafts and much more!

As a PV you will lead **community action projects**. While working in the community you meet locals and become part of their lives. You will develop through training and support as you build professional skills and learn about Indian culture.



PVs live at Sangam and come for either of two terms:

- June to September (3 ½ months)
- September to March (6 months)

Applicants should be motivated, have a strong background in Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting, a good sense of humour and a friendly smile!

The hours can sometimes be long and there is always plenty of work to be done. A good level of fitness and stamina are necessary to keep you going.
